


Introduction



For three decades he has written, composed, improvised, recorded and produced hundreds of works in various musical idioms. He has worked with a diverse range of artists such as Danna & Clément, Steve Roach, Vidna Obmana, Jeff Pearce, Bruce Mitchell, Roger Calverley, Loreena McKennitt, Trichy Sankaran and many others. He lives in the countryside with his wife and five cats.

Hilliard Brozin is a composer signed to Sony Music Publishing.
Hilliard lives in Johannesburg, South Africa with his wife and two young children. Hilliard has been on an EMI album with Vangelis, Ennio Morricone, Sarah Brightman, Enigma, Mike Oldfield, Eric Serra and Yanni.
Hilliard learned music as a young child and is also a qualified attorney.

Ethereal Journeys is an ambient composer living in the Russian Federation. He counts Arno, Dean Evenson, Djivan Gasparyan, Hans Zimmer, Tuu, Tenhi among his influences. Most of his compositions are inspired by the natural world.



THE WILDLANDS

The wilderness has often been associated with the unknown, at times both feared and revered. This "back country", or hinterland, as it's been termed, was the inland region behind a port. On some historical maps it was simply labelled terra incognita -- Latin for "unknown land." Early cartographers would even designate such regions with the fanciful warning -- "Here be dragons".

"The WILDLANDS" provides a rare glimpse into the mystery and raw beauty of some of Canada's wilderness regions. Gathered from different wilderness tracts hundreds of miles apart, these recordings take you to the wild lands just beyond civilization and then even *deeper* into the untamed and undiscovered wild.

Recorded in the two provinces of Ontario and Quebec, this album highlights three distinct wilderness regions: Kipawa in central Quebec, Hastings County in Eastern Ontario and Queen Elizabeth II Wildlands Provincial Park in South-Central Ontario.

Kipawa in central Quebec is an outpost to the great Quebec wilderness stretching into the far north. Deep lakes and unbroken forests are typical of this region. **Hastings County** contains within it vast wetlands including the Lingham Lake area which is key to southeastern Ontario's watershed and is a habitat for a wide variety of migratory birds. **Queen Elizabeth II Wildlands Provicial Park** is the largest tract of undisturbed wilderness in South-Central Ontario and home to many rare








BRUCE MITCHELL

Bruce Mitchell is a prominent Canadian composer and recording artist who has four solo albums released internationally. He began his musical training at age eight on accordion and guitar. As his interest in music grew he studied piano and composition. His primary musical influences were

Bach, Beethoven, and Debussy.

In the 1960's he was a folk singer in the Toronto scene and was also a lead vocalist in a progressive rock band. Mitchell set up his own digital music studio and soon he was scoring films and awardwinning TV documentaries such as NATURE WATCH. His music is also featured on many compilations including the NARADA CHRISTMAS COLLECTION (1988).

Mitchell, partly of Welsh and Scottish descent, has had an interest in Celtic culture for many years. His previous work includes playing keyboards in a Celtic group and performing and arranging selected tracks on CELTIC MYSTERIES (OASCD 1003) and AVALON (OASCD 1006).





On his second release for MIRAGE, R.S. Thompson daringly ventures into darker sound territories, going below the sonic surfaces of his first release, THE SILENT SHORE (MIR 301). His signature style traverses between the regions of dissonant darkness and consonant light. FRONTIER connotes a mysterious world where black and white dissolve into an ocean of diverging and blending hues. All twelve tracks segue seamlessly into an experience of dark, wondrous reverie and mesmerizing temporal stasis.

The Ambient Expanse is a five movement, collaborative work created by two generations of ambient artists. Steve envisioned the Expanse concept -- "A pure, atmospheric music expressive of deep exploration and high optimism". He then invited a group of artists who felt an affinity with



the project and its aim to create a unified flow of expansive and uplifting pieces. The music is divided into five movements - one for each artist. The spirit of the project was brought to life by Roach's signature production style and masterful mixing techniques in his Tucson-based studio, *The Timeroom*. The result is a powerful statement of sustained beauty that is sure to inspire those who have been missing the pure atmospheric non-rhythmic expressions.

IMAGINARIUM - *MA JA LE/Vir Uni*s MIR 303

On this cutting-edge album, the U.S. Midwest ambient duo MA JA LE (Chris Short - Guitars / Paul Vnuk - Synths) teams with ambient groove wizard and sound forger VIR UNIS to create a remarkable blend of "Tribal Groove Dream Scapes." 

Shortly after discovering this place I returned early one Sunday morning to record the sounds of "The Forest Marsh" awakening at dawn.
